Aim

The course will incorporate the Australian and New Zealand Anaesthetic Allergy Group (ANZAAG) guidelines. The session will satisfy the ANZCA CPD program requirements for Anaphylaxis, and the course is suitable for ANZCA trainees who need to complete an Anaphylaxis course. This course promotes a team-based approach and anaesthesia assistants are encouraged to attend with their medical colleagues.
